

The Minister of Environment Protection and Agriculture of Georgia Met the Farmers of Shida Kartli

Today we have had a meeting in Shida Kartli, the Ministry has planned to visit almost in every region in order to have talks with farmers and provide them with the information about the results of the current projects as about those new initiatives which are planned from the next year,” announced Levan Davitashvili.
