Giorgi Khojevanishvili met with the IDPs living in Antsukhelidze street

Giorgi Khojevanishvili,-the State Representative in Shida Kartli, Amiran Kristesiashvili,-the Deputy of the State Representative, Mamuka Tsotniashvili,- the Deputy Minister of Internally Displaced Persons from the Occupied Territories, Labour, Health and Social Affairs of Georgia and the representative of the President's office in Gori met with the IDPs in the Kombinati settlement and listened to their requirements. It is worth mentioning that a bit earlier, during Giorgi Khojevanishvili's meeting with the IDPs, the issue of building a new kindergarten was arisen. Building of a kindergarten in Antsukhelidze street is planned this year.
