

Multi-functional sports complex will be built in Gori

In Gori, a symbolic capsule was laid into the foundation of Sports Palace. The Minister of Sport and Youth, Taniel Khechkashvili, Acting Shida Kartli Governor, Ioseb Okromelidze and Mayor of Gori Zurab Jirkvelishvili laid the capsule into the foundation of the building. Canadian company "BEHLEN Industries" will build the sports palace. Two multifunctional sports complexes with two halls will be built in Gori, which will be meant for different sports and it will promote development of professional and massive professional sport. The large hall of the palace is intended for 1500 visitors and the small one – for 500 visitors. The project is implemented in the framework of "Sports Infrastructure Development State Program" and plans to build three multifunctional sports complexes in Georgian in 2016-2017. Sports complexes in Telavi, Batumi and Gori will be built first.
